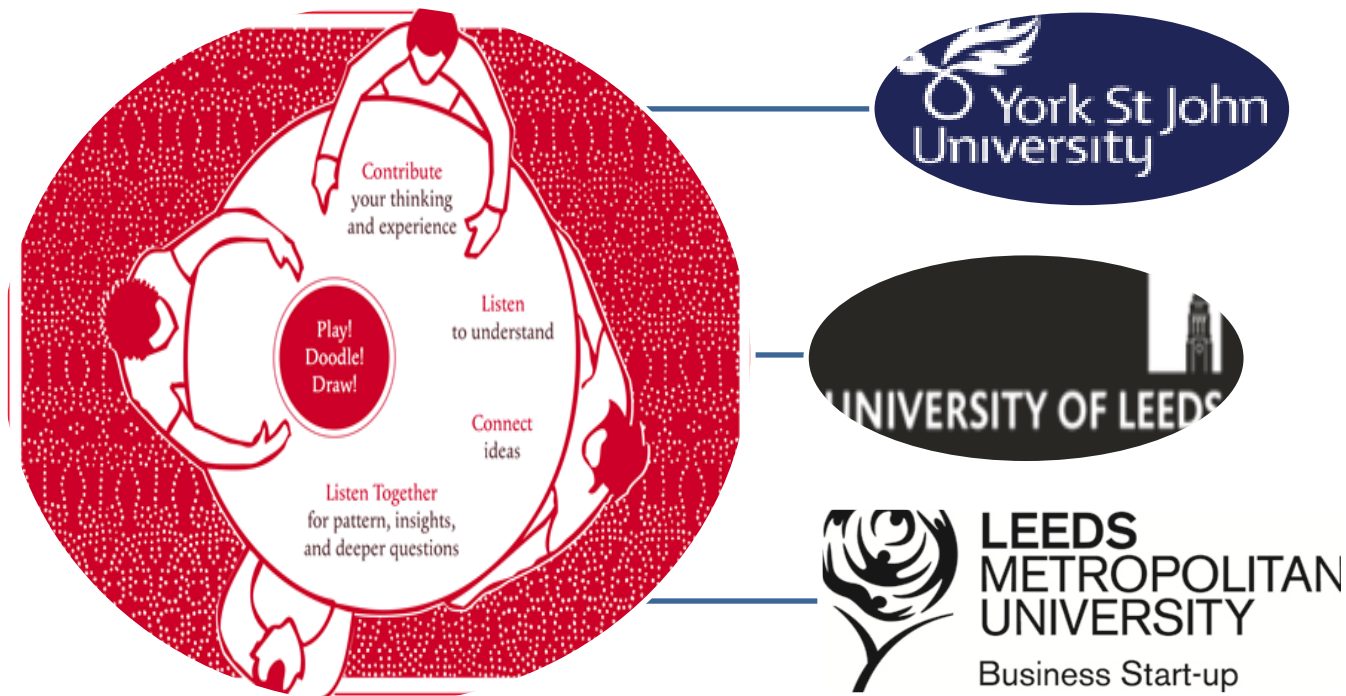


World Café – Networking to Discover Learning about Networks
